Comprehensive Services

At the Achievement Centers for Children, our goal is to help children with disabilities develop the skills they need to realize their full potential.

Our highly-trained and licensed physical, occupational and speech/language therapists use clinical observation and standard assessments, along with information gathered from the family, physicians and other professionals, to obtain a global view of a child's functioning.

We provide comprehensive services to complement a child's rehabilitation therapy, offering education, recreation and family support in a single service plan designed to meet the needs of each family.

We are committed to helping families identify additional community resources and will act as advocates as they learn to navigate the complex programs available.



Strengthening Abilities

We work with families to establish therapy plans and goals, and design home program activities to maximize progress. Therapies are available on an outpatient basis or in tandem with our other programs.

Our experienced therapists can develop and implement ongoing, long-range therapies or customized intensive sessions using cutting-edge, research-based treatment methods.

- **Physical Therapy** provides treatment to increase range of motion, strength, endurance, balance, coordination and mobility skills.
- **Occupational Therapy** uses a variety of treatment approaches and activities to address fine motor, self care, areas of sensory deficit, and play skills.
- **Speech/Language Therapy** helps the child develop communication skills, both speech and language, using the most appropriate method, including alternative methods such as sign language or computer-aided communication.
